Welcome to Daytona Beach Resort & Conference Center – Code of Conduct and Hotel Regulations

1. Florida State Law requires THAT YOU MUST BE 21 TO PURCHASE< CONSUME OR POSSESS Alcoholic Beverages within the State of Florida. "Local City Ordinance prohibits open alcoholic containers on any public property including streets, sidewalks, the beach or inside a vehicle". No beer kegs are allowed in guest rooms, on pool decks or other Hotel property. A person of legal age cannot sell or provide alcoholic beverages to any person under age 21. 2. Local Ordinance now prohibits the sales of alcoholic beverages between 3AM and 7AM by all licensed alcohol properties. This ordinance also prohibits the consumption of alcoholic after 2AM at outside bars. All outside bars will remain closed until 11AM the following day. Any person convicted of violating any provisions of the City Ordinance shall be punished as provided in Section 1-5 (a) of the Code of the City of Daytona Beach. 3. CLIMBING/JUMPING ON OR OVER BALCONY RAILINGS IS PROHIBITED, this also includes windows, roofs, or ledges. It is extremely dangerous and illegal, pursuant to Florida Statutes 509 and 887.03. Hotel operators are authorized to detain individuals engaged in any of these violations until a law enforcement officer arrives. VIOLATORS WILL BE ARRESTED AND PROSECUTED. 4. TAMPERING WITH ANY FIRE SAFETY DEVICE IS A FELONY of the third degree under Florida Statutes and will result in eviction from the hotel, arrest and prosecution. Entrance doors in guest rooms must be kept closed at all times. Stairways, balconies and hallways must be kept clear for obvious safety reasons. 5. Occupancy of guest rooms is strictly limited to number of persons registered in room (max. 4). VISITORS ARE PERMITTED ONLY UNTIL 11PM. NON-REGISTERED OCCUPANTS MAY NOT USE GUEST ROOMS OR HOTEL PREMISES AS A DWELLING PLACE. Violators will be subjected to prosecution and possible forfeiture of paid monies and eviction. Florida Statute 509.141 (Fraud of an Innkeeper). 6. Ramp Gates are closed from 12:30AM until 6:30AM except for Special Events. If you leave the ramps, please call the Front Desk and the gates will be opened, BUT NOT FOR RE-ENTRY. 7. Excessive noise or music is prohibited. Loud and noisy parties or behavior will not be condoned at any time. Violators will be asked to leave. 8. For Safety reasons, ABSOLUTELY NO GLASS PRODUCTS are allowed on the pool deck or any area of the hotel outside your room. Also, coolers are not allowed on the pool deck. 9. All Pool Deck furnishings and Hotel property must STAY ON POOL DECK AREA. 10. IDENTIFICATION will be required to obtain a room key, purchase drinks, cash travelers checks or for other reasonable purposes. 11. Pool hours, key deposits, security deposits, phone charges, room payment, check-in and check-out times all vary according to the individual hotel policies. Occupancy of a guest room signifies the acceptance of these policies, rules, and regulations, thereby constituting a special contract between the hotel operator and the guest (Florida Statute 509.101). 12. DAMAGE OF HOTEL PROPERTY WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE REGISTERED GUESTS. Furnishings, linens, or towels should never be removed from any guest room. All rooms will be inspected upon check-out. 13. AUTOMOBILE TRAFFIC IS PERMITTED ON CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE OCEANFRONT BEACHES FROM ONE HOUR BEFORE SUNRISE UNTIL ONE HOUR PAST SUNSET UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED AT THE ENTRANCE BOOTH TO THE BEACH. You are warned that this is a hazardous condition. You must be alert and cautious. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY. 14. Absolutely nothing is to be thrown from the balcony. Throwing anything from the balcony is a 3rd Degree Felony and will be cause for immediate eviction. 15. **Actions causing immediate evictions from the Hotel are: Misconduct Tampering with any FIRE SAFETY device, underage drinking, climbing over balconies, throwing articles from the balcony, excessive noise, radios, loud parties, causing problems for other guests. I HAVE READ AND SO ABIDE BY THESE REGULATIONS.**
